

## Osborne Park Hospital and Sir Charles Gairdner Hospital Combined Endoscopy Service

Patients referred to the Combined Endoscopy Service will be triaged to either Osborne Park Hospital or Sir Charles Gairdner Hospital for endoscopic procedures, depending on clinical requirements and best available booking times. Low-risk day procedures are being performed at Osborne Park Hospital under the Ambulatory Surgery Initiative. Under the ASI specialist fees are bulk-billed to Medicare (the patient has no out-of-pocket expense for the procedure). For a patient to be treated under the ASI referral option (i) a doctor's referral to an individual (named) specialist is required; and (ii) prior to treatment, the patient must elect to be seen as a private (non-admitted) patient.
